No need to remove paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, tape, wire, metal fasteners, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs.



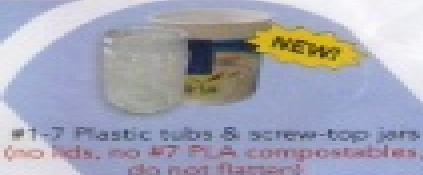

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# *Sewer System*

All residents and guests,

Clear Lake Association continues to spent many thousands of dollars flushing out the drain lines of our sewer system due to residents and possibly their guests flushing items down the toilet and sinks that should not be put in the sewer system.

Please discuss these items with all members of your household as this is getting quite expensive and coming out of the Lake budget. Other items that should not be put down the drain are things like, grease, vegetable skins, or anything that would disrupt the flow or the balance of the sewer system. Residents who have renters, need to also share this information with their tenants.

## **What Not to Flush – Things You Should Never Flush Down the Toilet**

If you want to keep it simple, just remember this: never flush anything but human waste and toilet paper. Even with this, you'll want to be careful not to flush too much toilet paper at one time (to avoid a clogged toilet). Are you surprised? Have you thought it was okay to flush other things down the toilet? The following are items people commonly think are okay to flush but aren't. We've provided reasons why you shouldn't flush these items so you'll understand the rationale behind the rule.

### **Sanitary Products**

It might seem natural to flush these items down, but they'll clog your pipes and land you a visit from the plumber.

#### **Wipes**

Again, it might seem like an intuitive thing to flush, but wipes (baby wipes, facial wipes included) are made of materials that don't break down. They can get snagged or bunched up together and clog up your pipes.

#### **Floss**

You'd think it's so small that it wouldn't cause a problem, but it doesn't biodegrade and can get tangled around toilet paper, causing clogs in pipes.

# *Sewer System*

## **Prescription Drugs and Over-The-Counter Medications**

While it might seem like a safe way to dispose of expired medications, you're just dumping chemicals into the water system. Our water treatment plants are not equipped to remove all those chemicals from the water. In fact the EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) advises you to dispose of medications by sealing them in a plastic bag and disposing of them in the trash. (While you're thinking about what is in our water system, consider reading about [water filtration systems](#) and why even the Obama administration advises home owners to install water filters.)

## **Kitty Litter**

Kitty litter (especially clay kitty litter) will clog your pipes for sure. Even the "flushable" kind is debatable, as it can still clog your pipes (much as the manufactures will claim it won't), and Toxoplasmosis, a parasite found in kitty waste, is harmful to marine biology. We want to keep kitty waste out of our water system.

## **Diapers**

Don't even think about it. Your chances of a nasty clogged toilet are astronomically high.

## **Paper Towels**

We know it's convenient to swipe the bathroom counter and toss the paper towel down the toilet, but you're playing Russian roulette with a clogged pipe. Paper towels, even if torn into little pieces and flushed separately (which wastes a lot of water) will not break down and will cause clogs in your pipe.

## **Facial Tissue**

Facial tissue doesn't break down like toilet paper does, but there's yet another reason not to flush it: to save water. It's never a good idea to use the toilet as a trash can. You're wasting anywhere from 2-5 gallons of water every time you flush.

## **Cigarette Butts**

Cigarettes contain chemicals that you don't want entering the water supply. Keep in mind that sewerage is treated and recycled, so we want to keep our water as chemical-free as possible.

## **Condoms**

These cause more problems that you'd imagine, because they get tangled up in other stuff and cause clogged pipes.



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# *Lake Water Quality & Fishing*

- Lake treated several times for algae and moss condition.
- Continuing to have Mike Gutzmer test and monitor our water quality.
- Propose to have an updated aeration system installed.
- Stocked both grass carp and walleye and bass this year.

# Fishing Reminders

- **Clear Lake is a “Catch & Release” Lake.**
  - **Please return all un-injured fish to the lake for all to enjoy and fish reproduction.**
  
- **Guests are allowed to join residents when fishing @ Clear Lake, however they are not allowed to fish on their own when not accompanied by a property owner and cannot harvest fish for personal use.**

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# Personal Watercraft

## *Boat Motors:*

- Outboard - motors shall not exceed 90 manufacturer stated horsepower. A motor larger than 90 horsepower can use an alternate source of power with the boat motor tilted up and out of the water.
- Inboard - motors shall not exceed 135 manufacturer stated horsepower
- Jet Ski's - shall not exceed 100 horsepower
- All watercrafts need to bear the Clear Lake sticker
- Proof of Insurance Liability required of residents owning personal watercraft

# *Boating / Personal Watercraft Time Reminder*

## Boating, Skiing and Surfboarding Times:

- 10:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. every day of the week, excluding Sundays and holidays
- 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays and holidays
- Trolling speed in effect at hours not listed (trolling speed is as slow as your boat will run, there is NO WAKE behind the boat when running at trolling speed)
- Regardless of the hours listed, no full speed or fast boating is permitted after dark. All p.m. hours listed will drop back one hour if daylight savings time is discontinued.

# *Boating / Personal Watercraft*

- Operators of boats and jet skis must be at least 16 years of age unless they have completed a watercraft safety course.
- Nebraska law requires any motorboat operator (including personal watercraft) born after December 31, 1985, complete a Boating Safety Course and be in possession of a course certificate when operating the boat. You must be at least 14 years of age to operate a motorboat (including personal watercraft) in Nebraska. Classes are offered throughout the state in several options.
- Please observe one-way traffic in a clockwise pattern.
- Clear Lake allows only 3 motorized watercrafts on the water at any time.

# *Boating / Personal Watercraft*

- New Clear Lake stickers for 2016 for all motorized boats and jet skis.
- Clear Lake Board is adopting new log for tracking boats and sizes, owners and liability insurance compliance.



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# *Work Day Credit Policy*

- Currently we have three (3) scheduled work days and the Work Day Credit is \$ 30 per work day
- If a husband and wife both work at the work day and they own one lot, they will receive \$ 30 credit. If they both work and they own multiple lots, it is assumed that they are each working for a lot and will receive \$ 30 credit for each person.
- If a renter works at the work day they can receive credit for the lot owner also.
- If the lot owner's children do some work and the lot owner feels it was a sufficient amount to warrant getting credit they can mark it on the sheet.
- We also have Exemptions for the Lake Board, SID Board, and Treasurer.
- Note: prior to 2010, you would have received work credits towards your annual membership. Going forward, you will be billed for work days not attended.
- **2016 work assessment: Each work day that you do not attend, \$30 will be added to your 2015 lake assessment**

# *Work Day Credits*

- Motivation to have residents get involved around the lake, take pride in our community and save the lake association money on projects we can do ourselves.
- Excellent way to meet your neighbors
- Exemptions to work days: Clear Lake Boards, SID #1 BOD.

# *Lake Reminders*

- Bagworm treatment on residents and common property trees (spray in May & June).
- Residents are responsible for sprinkler repairs across from their property
- Maintain 15 mph speed limit around the lake/renters
- Pet owners keep pets on leashes and clean up after their pets
- Review lake rules and regulations (posted on our website)
- Construction projects: all must be pre-approved.
- Unlicensed Vehicles & parking on common areas are not allowed
- Contact Diggers Hotline for all underground digging.

# *Lake Reminders*

- Parking – Clear Lake does not allow parking on the common property or shelter area on a long term basis. 24 hours maximum
- Local Wildlife: Please do not feed the ducks / geese.
  - Mess on the beaches - Swimmer itch w/ snails
- Phosphorus-free Fertilizer Regulations

Clear Lake mandates a phosphorus-free fertilizer regulation.

  - Too much phosphorous in the water results in an over-abundance of algae growth in the water which lowers the oxygen levels, this introduces poisonous toxins and results in fish kill.
